

ENERGY SAVINGS INITIATIVE

In 2014, Senva, Inc made it a goal to cut energy consumption throughout our operations, including production. Call it our roots, but being part of the Oregon business climate it just feels natural to take all the steps we can to reduce our environmental impact for the benefit of our customers, our families, our community and our planet. Since 2014, we have taken the following steps to increase our energy efficiency and reduce our carbon footprint.

HVAC System - Installed an electrical submeter in our building panel. Identified one rooftop unit was running off schedule. Adjusted schedule so the unit only operates during standard business hours. We also recently had our HVAC system air-balanced to maximize efficiency. Installation of Senva CO2 sensors has allowed us to maintain healthy indoor air quality while minimizing wasted energy.

Lighting - Installed motion sensors in common use areas including meeting rooms, break rooms and restrooms. Upgraded all light fixtures with energy efficient bulbs.

PC Power Management - Utilized software to power down computers and monitors when not in use.

Appliance Upgrades - Upgraded all kitchen appliances to energy star rated models.

Paper Waste - Converting all incoming faxes to digital format.

Kitchen Equipment - Replaced all disposable dishes and utensils with reusable dishware and silverware.

Recycling Methods - Established multiple recycling stations throughout office to separate our paper, plastics, metals and glass for recycling pickup.
